



AmeriHealth Caritas Ohio serves members with a wide range of language and communication needs. The top languages AmeriHealth Caritas Ohio members speak other than English are: Spanish, Haitian-Creole, Ukrainian, Arabic, and Swahili. The most requested languages for interpretation are: Haitian-Creole, Spanish, Nepali, Arabic, and Swahili. Effective communication is essential in healthcare, especially for patients with Limited English Proficiency (LEP). Although interpretation and translation are often used interchangeably, they serve different purposes. Translation and interpreting services help members and providers communicate clearly across languages and access essential information and services.

Translation involves converting written healthcare materials from one language to another, such as consent forms, discharge instructions, medication guides and patient education materials. Translators can research medical terminology and revise their work to help ensure accuracy.

Interpretation involves converting spoken language in real time. Healthcare interpreters assist during medical appointments, hospital visits, and emergency situations by facilitation communication between patients and healthcare providers.

The main difference is that translation focuses on **written communication**, while interpretation focuses on **spoken communication**. Both services help improve patient understanding, support informed decision making and reduce the risk of medical errors.

Language barriers can contribute to lower-quality care, poorer clinical outcomes, longer hospital stays, and higher readmission rates. Providing language

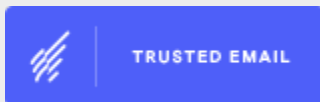
assistance helps ensure patients with limited English proficiency receive high-quality care.

Professional interpreters and translators play a critical role in providing equitable, safe and effective healthcare for diverse populations.

AmeriHealth Caritas Ohio provides interpreting and translation services to support members' language access needs. As of June of 2026, 10% of AmeriHealth Caritas members speak a language other than English, serving members in 117 different languages.
